
**Construction** Students and staff will temporarily relocate during construction.

### Construction Begins SUMMER 2021 and continues through the summer of 2024.



### **Construction Activities**

- The construction schedule typically runs from 7 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Work will occur on some evenings and on some weekends and will comply with City of Portland noise permit requirements.
- There will be construction traffic impacts in the neighborhood that will vary throughout the three-year construction phase.
- Street closures are not anticipated at this time.
- All adjacent Portland Parks facilities including Buckman Field and the tennis courts will remain open.
- The PPS-owned Benson parking lot will become the new Multiple Pathways to Graduation (MPG) school building.
- Site security is a priority. Construction fencing will surround the active areas of the site. Please help us stop vandalism and keep the site safe.
