"In a classroom, students need to feel comfortable. Shared classrooms prevent student work from being displayed, decreasing ownership and comfort."










Gyms and Performing Arts have similar needs, but shouldn't be directly adjacent






## **Secured Space vs Public Space**



## **Daily Access vs Evening Access**





## **Courtyard Elevation Changes**






## **Loading Constraints**
