MEETING SUMMARY:

The Cleveland High School Design Advisory Group (DAG) held their first meeting on May 9. The DAG members were selected through an application process and represent a mix of students, staff, parents, and community members. The purpose of the DAG is to meet with the design team (PPS + Mahlum/Studio Petretti) on a regular basis to provide input on the evolving details of the design. As DAG members entered the room, those who lived in the catchment area were asked to place a pin on the map showing what mode of transportation they used to get to Cleveland High School. After introductions, PPS reviewed the DAG charter and the group elected Co-Chairpersons. PPS also provided an overview of the project schedule and bond funding for the Cleveland High School modernization.

The design team presented an analysis of the Cleveland High School site, and showed some of the different site configurations that were explored in the comprehensive planning process. The design team reviewed the project vision and goals, and the recommended approach outlined in the comprehensive plan.

A larger site plan showed how all three Cleveland Sites, and potentially Powell Park, will be utilized. The design team reviewed community engagement to-date, including the comprehensive planning committee, staff and student groups, public workshops, community based organizations and affinity groups, and a PPS survey.
