Construction moves steadily toward completion

Starting with a clean slate in the winter of 2016 the new Faubion PK-8 has risen steadily out of the ground over the last several months. Concrete foundations, masonry block walls, structural steel and roofs have framed the various sections of the building that will house the gym, classrooms and community services facilities of the rebuilt school. Throughout the rest of the fall and into the next year of the building will take shape as we head toward completion of the project in the summer of 2017.

PPS/Concordia University partnership: a new model for education

The new Faubion PK- 8/Concordia University building with its 3 to PhD® initiative will be the heartbeat of the neighborhood, offering wrap-around services to the Faubion community and Concordia students. The new building will combine Faubion School, the Concordia University College of Education, an early childhood education center, a health and wellness center, state of the art STEAM/ Maker Space facilities, a food club with organic and nutritious products and other services for the school community.

FALL 2014 – SUMMER 2015

Planning, design and fundraising.

FALL 2015 – SPRING 2017

Faubion is demolished and rebuilt.

Faubion PK-8 students have relocated to Tubman School 2231 N. Flint Ave. during construction of the new building and will return to the new Faubion School in September 2017. Yellow school bus service will transport all Faubion students to Tubman School during this time.

Project Funding

The PPS School Building Improvement Bond is funding \$33 million for the project. Concordia University will contribute land, resources and funding (up to \$15.5 million).

Community involvement

Faubion's Master Plan was developed in partnership with PPS, Concordia University, Faubion staff, BORA Architects, families, students and community members. Throughout the Planning and Design process to date we have had over 30 community engagement meetings, nine Design Advisory Group (DAG) meetings and two Open Houses to share this exciting process with the community.
