### VISION + GOALS

#### 3 TO PhD®

3 to PhD<sup>®</sup> is a trailblazing educational model to create safer, healthier, and more educated communities from early learning through Pursuing one's Highest Dreams (PhD). The goal is to close the opportunity gap for our children, 3 to PhD<sup>®</sup> restores school as the heartbeat of a community.



### HISTORY

James Blair Faubion was born in Portland in 1926, attended Fernwood School, and graduated from Grant High School in 1944. After joining the U.S. Marine Corps, Faubion was sent to Okinawa, Japan, where he was wounded, paralyzed, and lost both legs. After his death in 1949, a grateful community named the school in his honor. This tribute is a daily reminder that heroes exist in both peace and war.

Faubion School and Concordia University Portland have been neighbors in education for over 63 years, sharing 24 adjacent acres in Northeast Portland, just 102 steps apart.

Voters approved a Portland Public Schools (PPS) capital improvement bond in November 2012. PPS is Oregon's largest district with over 48,000 students. Faubion School was the only elementary school slated for rebuild because of the private, nonprofit partnership with Concordia University Portland.

Becoming the first 3 to PhD® campus in the nation, it will serve up to 800 PK-8 children, 81% of whom are eligible to receive free or reduced lunch. Concordia University Portland's College of Education is fully integrated, preparing future educators within a diverse and urban school.

The vibrant student population reflects the community it serves, and the neighborhood is thriving and growing.



Annually, more than 300 Concordia University Portland volunteers support students and teachers with reading, math. and science.

#### GROUND FLOOR

#### **COMMUNITY WELCOME**

The main entrance and drop off area was relocated to Dekum Street. The first floor includes a gorgeous Welcome Hall featuring the school's main office, family resource room, Food Club by Basics, and Kaiser Permanente 3 to PhD® Wellness Center. The first floor houses the early childhood education center (offering care for 6-week-olds to four-year-old) and kindergarten classes. The cafeteria and gym are located on the east side of the building. A music room is also on the first floor. The playstructure includes slides, swings, and accessible play areas.

#### SECOND FLOOR

#### LEARNING

The 1st through the 4th grade student classrooms are on the second floor, which also feature a Library and Media Center, Maker Spaces, STEAM, conference rooms, and additional flexible spaces. Concordia University Portland, College of Education Offices, Faculty Studio, Resource Center are integrated throughout the building.
