MEETING MINUTES

- I. Opening of presentation made.
- II. Overview and summary of the options were completed.
- III. DAG Q&A
 - a. Question taken from the DAG included:
 - i. Why was this the only program element to be removed?
 - ii. Why has there been a delay in updating the DAG on this important revision?
 - b. Dedicated time for the DAG gave way to comments and questions that came in from the community.
- IV. Community Q&A
 - a. Most of the remaining time allotted for the meeting was spent on taking questions and comments from the community. Numerous comments and questions were made. The following is a sample of them that were noted:
 - i. Most comments made were in support of keeping the softball field as per the original master plan in the North Field.
 - ii. Questions regarding Title IX were raised. How Title IX is defined and applies to the softball field will need follow up.
 - iii. We have an opportunity to make it right and provide the softball team with a good facility.
 - iv. What opportunities are out there for corporate partnerships? How can the community help rally financial support? The community can help but not providing the field is not acceptable.
 - v. What participation is Parks making to receive the benefits of the upgrades made by PPS to their property? As an example Portland Parks & Recreation contributed over \$500K to the Grant Bowl project.
 - vi. Why is the Dog Off Leash Area such a large factor? Just move it.
 - vii. There are many other parks with softball fields that overlap with other uses, why is it such a big deal here?
 - viii. Could improvements to Wilshire Park be an option? In lieu of the North Field, could we look at making Wilshire Park a state of the art softball facility?
 - ix. Improvements to the Grant Bowl are wanted, but not at the expense of a dedicated softball field. The Grant Bowl is not ideal for a softball field.
 - x. Why not have the south field use as softball and relocate the baseball team?
 - xi. Many of the players noted that natural turf is preferred over artificial turf for softball.
 - xii. Softball at Wilshire or other remote location means more time away from the classroom.
- V. Due to the time needed for the extended Q&A session, time was limited to complete the planned workshop. However, the meeting was kept open over the planned period and opportunity to meet with smaller groups was made available. Many comments were collected. Attached are photos of the comments collected.

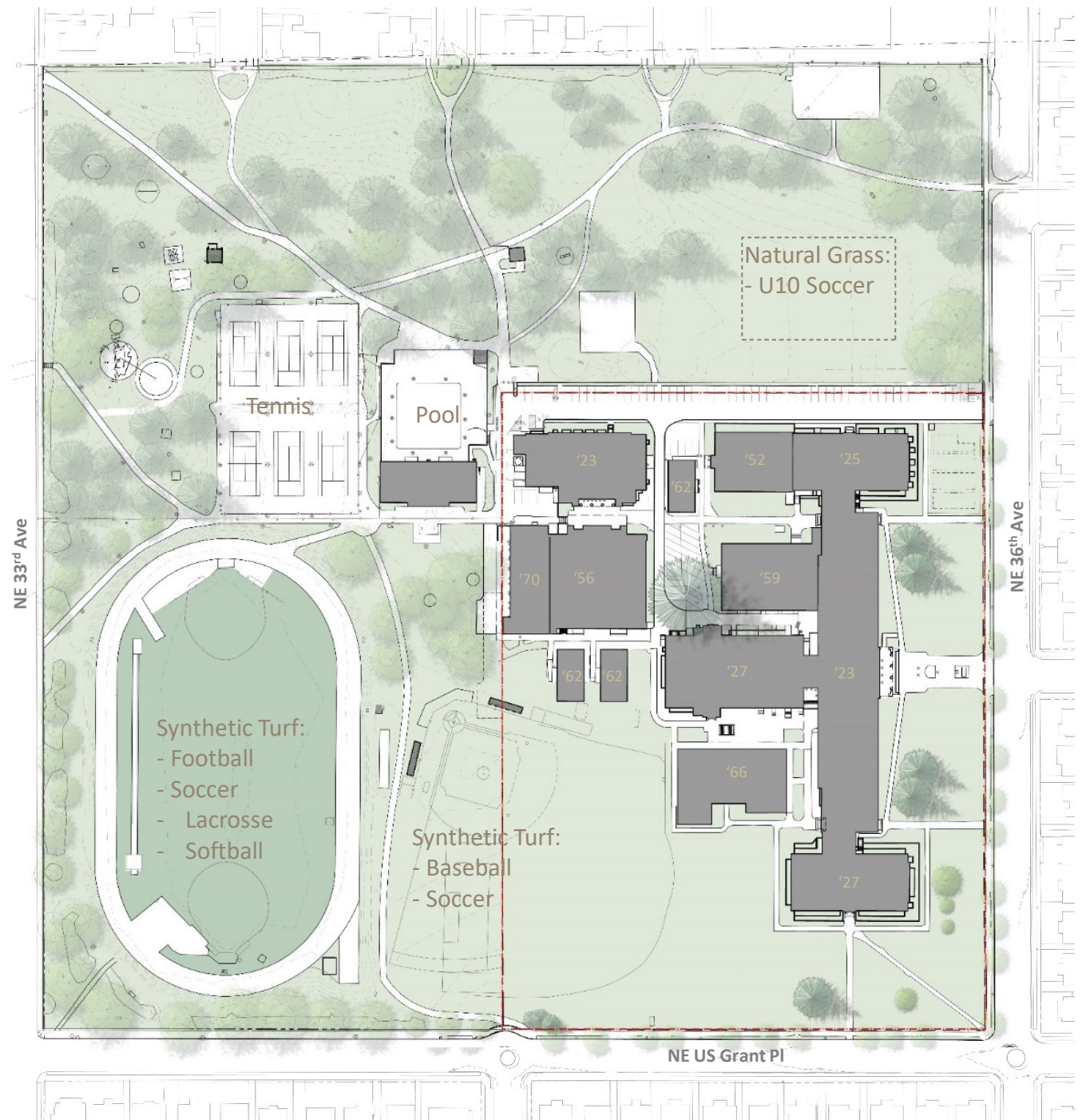


North Field

Remains As-is

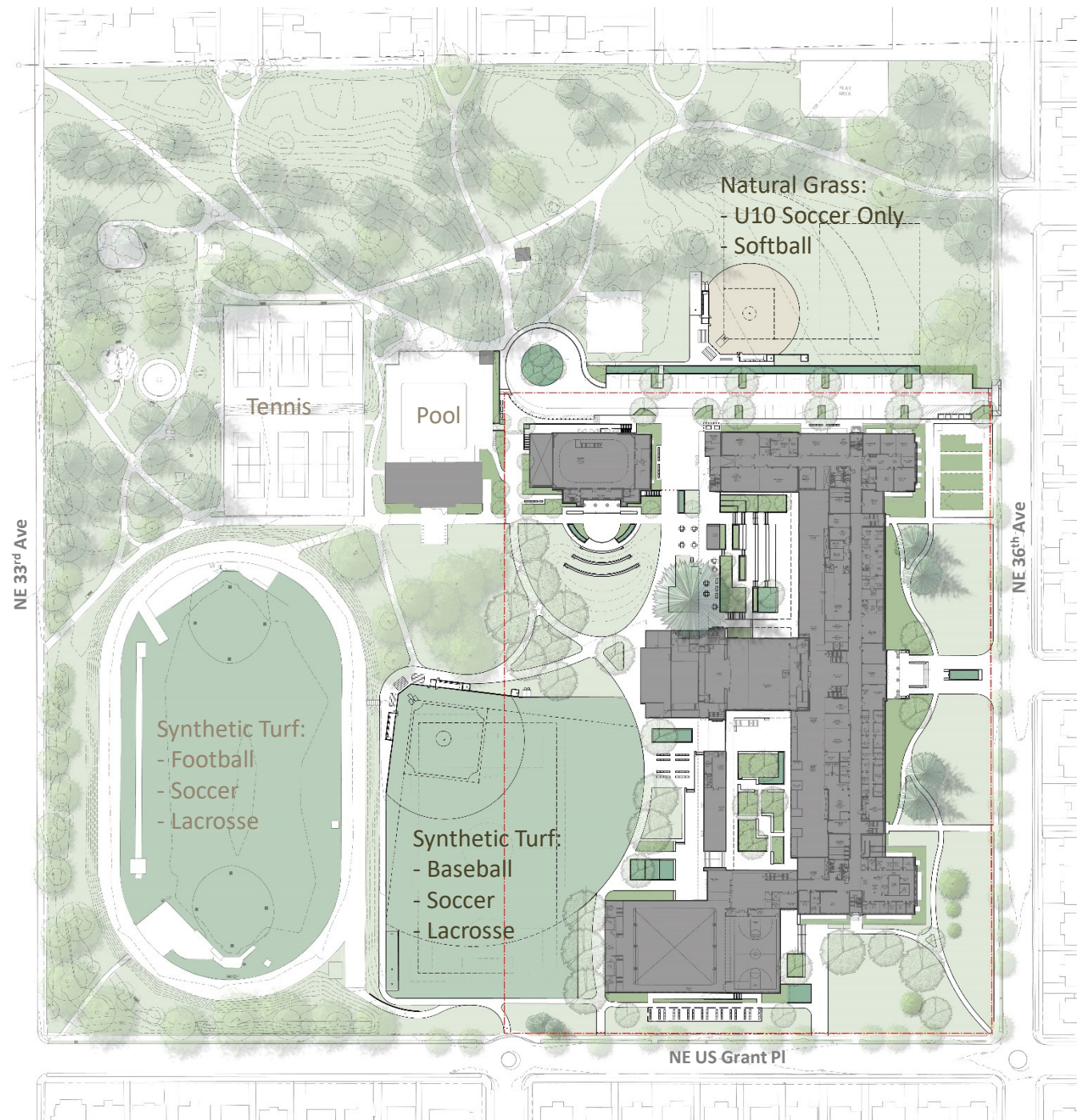
- Softball team continues to use Grant Bowl for practice when available, and
- Softball team continues to use Wilshire Park for practice and games



Option 2

Softball Field @ North Field

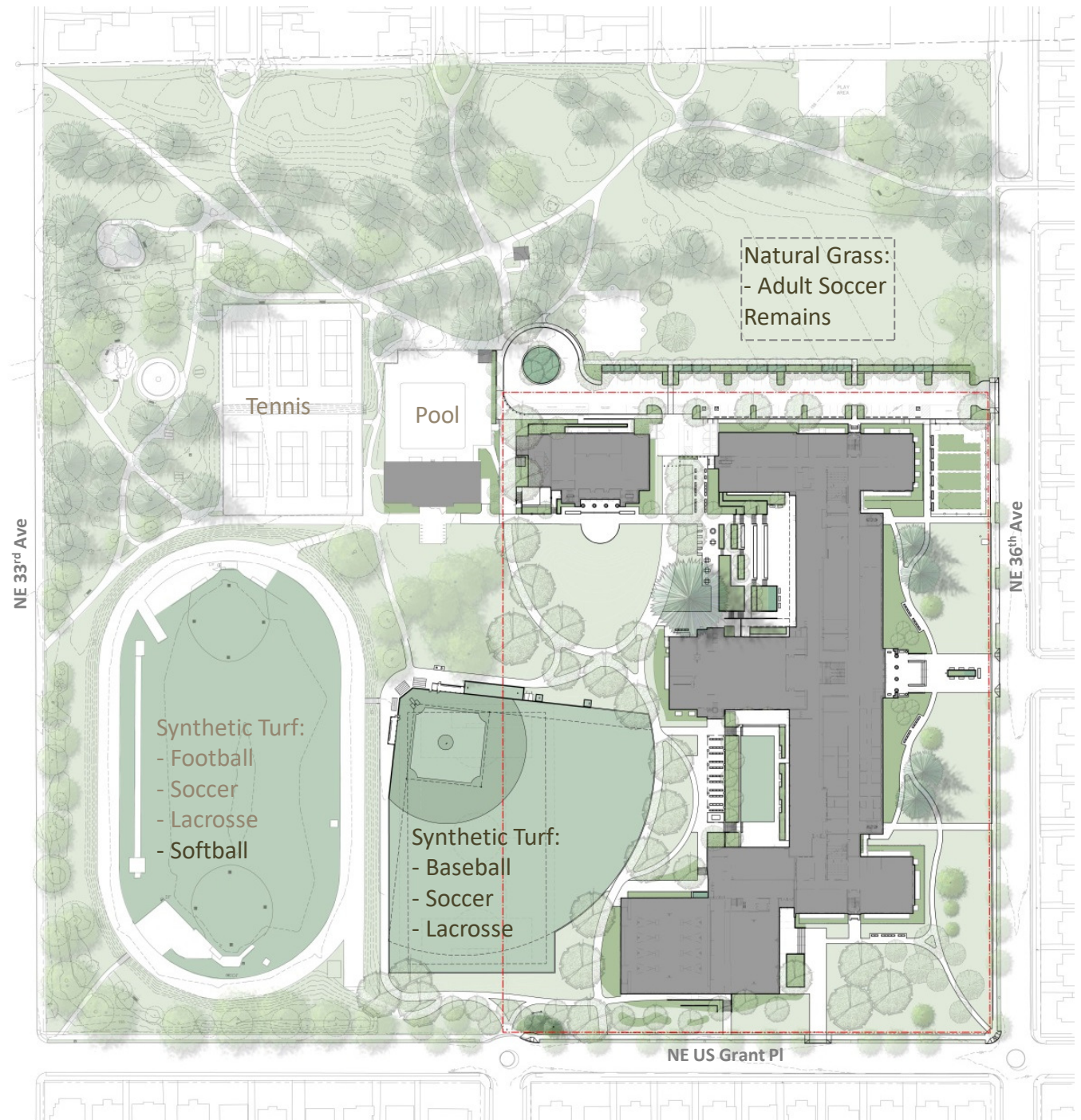
- Softball uses North Field for practice and games
- Continued use of Grant Bowl for practice when available
- Use of Wilshire Park will be affected due to scheduling of Park activities
- Additional requirements from original scope including safety netting, drinking fountain, ADA upgrades
- Land Use Approval is complete. Building Permit is needed.



Option 3

Grant Bowl Upgrades

- Grant Bowl is utilized for practice and games during evening hours and inclement weather
- Use of Wilshire Park remains an option
- Scope to include lighting, bleachers, crowd control fencing, concessions, restrooms
- Project will need to be set up to include Master Planning, Fundraising Land Use Approval, and permitting

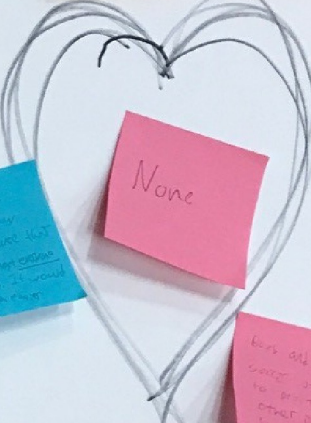
