#### **Modernization Moves Forward**

Grant is one of three high schools to be modernized as part of the 2012 PPS School Building Improvement Bond. The design of the new school was created through an extensive engagement process with numerous meetings involving school staff, students, alumni and community members. Construction will begin in the summer of 2017 and the work will last for two years, with the new Grant scheduled to open in the Fall of 2019.

## **Transition to the Marshall Campus**

Starting in the fall of 2017 Grant students will continue learning and participating in extracurricular activities at the Marshall Campus at 3905 SE 91st Ave. All Grant students will receive their student IDs on registration day at the Marshall Campus. Students IDs include Tri-Met passes, providing everyone free access on all Tri-Met transportation. Yellow bus service for special education students will continue.


