



PPS SCHOOL BUILDING IMPROVEMENT BOND

School ADA Improvements at: Harrison Park K-8, Holladay Center, Lent K-8, Markham K-5, Meek, Peninsula K-8, Richmond PK-5, West Sylvan

Twenty-seven Portland Public Schools are receiving facility improvements during the summer of 2015 as PPS launches into the third year of its \$482 million school building improvement bond program. Over the 8-year program as many as 67 schools, including three high schools, will be improved or modernized.

Summer 2015 projects- ADA Improvement Construction Details

- **Harrison Park:** New door hardware, and an upgrade to the lifestyles classroom
- **Holladay Center:** Upgrading the entryway from the parking lot to the front door
- **Lent K-8:** New door hardware
- **Markham K-5:** An ADA bathroom and better access to the playground area
- **Meek:** New door hardware and bathroom sinks and parking lot striping
- **Peninsula K-8 :** An upgraded accessible bathroom
- **Richmond PK-5:** A new ADA bathroom, better access to the cafeteria and security upgrades to the elevator
- **West Sylvan:** New door hardware throughout the school
