


Help Us Create a Modernized Jefferson High School

This group will be involved in developing the design of the modernized Jefferson High School by providing feedback on design details and options proposed by the project team. The DAG performs in an advisory role only. Decisions on project details are the responsibility of the Office of School Modernization in collaboration with other District Leadership.
