## Join the Jefferson Master Planning Committee (MPC)

PPS is seeking a diverse range of engaged citizens who can positively contribute to the process of creating a next generation high school in your community. The Jefferson Master Planning Committee will include students, parents, teachers, alumni, administrators, PPS staff, partners, community representatives and a school board member. They will be involved in developing the master plan for a modernized Jefferson High School. Although the final schedule of meetings has not been determined, committee members should plan on meeting about once a month in the evenings for about 6 months.



## The Master Planning Committee Mission

The goal of the Jefferson MPC is to develop a comprehensive, equitable, integrated and visionary high school campus design with authentic school community engagement. The MPC synthesizes community-wide input and collaborates around the evolving details of the project with other members in the Jefferson community. While MPC members do not make final decisions, their input is crucial in creating a comprehensive master plan that the entire community can be proud of.
