



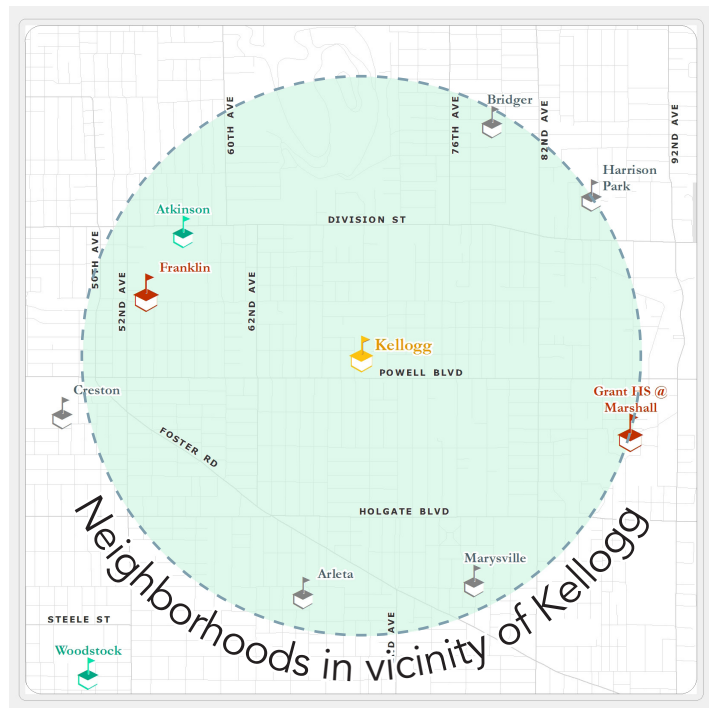
# Help Us Create a New Kellogg Middle School

## Seeking Community Engagement for the Design of a New Kellogg

Following passage of the 2017 bond, PPS is moving forward with planning, design and construction of a new Kellogg Middle School. The existing Kellogg building, which has not been used as a school for the past decade, will be removed and rebuilt. PPS is seeking public input on how the new Kellogg should be designed and is looking for volunteers to join the Kellogg Design Advisory Group (DAG).

## Join the Kellogg Design Advisory Group (DAG)

The Kellogg Design Advisory Group includes parents, teachers, students, and community representatives who will be involved in developing the design of the new Kellogg Middle School. The group will include at least one member representing each of the following: middle school parents, neighborhood parents, neighborhood associations, business associations, school programs, potential site and/or capital partners, students, teachers, and a school board representative.



## The Design Advisory Group Mission

The goal of the DAG is to develop comprehensive, equitable, integrated and visionary middle school campus master plans and schematic designs with authentic school community engagement. Members will be expected to serve for several months throughout the planning process.

## The Kellogg DAG will not engage in Kellogg Middle School Boundary Discussions

The Kellogg DAG will be limited to the planning and design of a new Middle School and will not address the District's separate and ongoing boundary discussions and decisions. **The feeder path and school boundaries for the new Kellogg Middle School have not been set and boundary decisions will not be discussed at the DAG meetings.** All nearby communities are invited to participate in the design process, but your participation will not influence school boundary decisions.
