Lincoln Rebuild Overview

In the Fall of 2022 the new multi-story Lincoln High School building will open on the west side of the existing campus. The Lincoln rebuild includes new performing arts spaces, CTE classrooms, a student commons, gymnasium, library/media center, and state of the art learning spaces. There will be a plaza adjacent to the commons for outdoor student activities and gatherings; the plaza connects the campus to the neighborhood through pedestrian-friendly design that features student bicycle parking and water efficient landscaping.

In 2023 the new track and field will open on the site currently occupied by the existing school. During construction of the new building, students will continue using the same Lincoln building. Construction activities will be separated by fencing providing a safe environment for students and staff.



New Lincoln Highlights

Cafeteria, Commons, and Plaza

The commons and outdoor plaza welcome students to the main entrance to Lincoln. These connected spaces serve as the heart of the school and campus.

Enhanced Arts Facilities

Specialized classrooms for 2D and 3D fine arts including photography, film, painting, and ceramics are on the top floor of the classroom building with abundant natural light.

STEM/Maker Space and Science Labs

STEM labs and a Makerspace with tools and equipment will support project-based learning and enhance career technical programs. New science labs will support inquiry based classes in IB Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Environmental Systems.

Career Technical Education CTE

Students can access specialized programs and labs for computer science, product design, mass communications, culinary arts, and business management programs

Performing Arts

The new performing arts facilities include a 500-seat theater, dedicated band and choir spaces, and a black box teaching theater.

Athletic Facilities

A new 1,700 seat main three court gym, weight room, wrestling/dance room, and a new track and field that includes a 1,500 seat grandstand.
