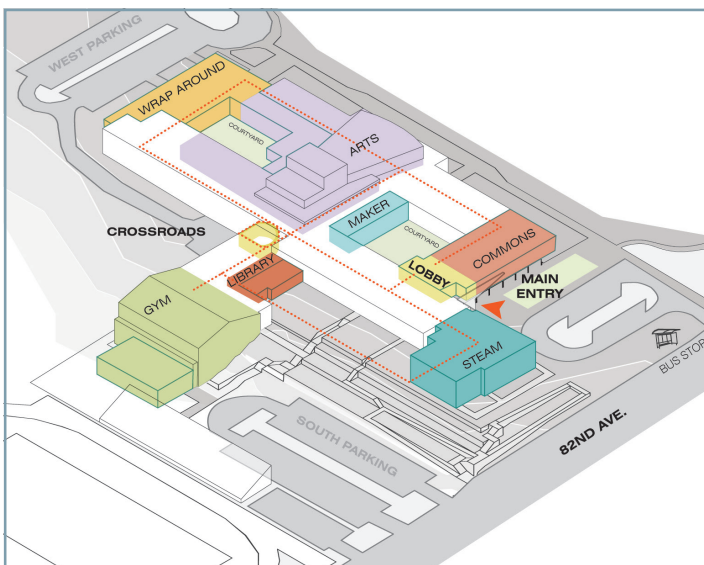


The Design Advisory Group Mission
