Modernization Overview

In the fall of 2021, Madison High School will reopen as a fully modernized a 292,000 square foot facility with a capacity for 1700 students. The school will include over 170,000 square feet of new construction, including a theater, commons and gym, that will blend seamlessly with the historic mid-century modern building. This new 21st century learning environment will provide Portland's most diverse student population, who speak over 30 languages with new facilities and opportunities for success.

The school was designed through a multi-year planning and design effort that gathered the ideas of hundreds of staff, students, and community stakeholders. This was accomplished through a series of listening sessions, public meetings and hands-on interactive workshops in order to create a campus that will inspire and support students and staff for decades to come.

Modernization Highlights

Cafeteria / Commons and Crossroads Atrium

The commons will serve as the heart of the modernized school and will act as a welcoming space at the main entrance. The Crossroads Atrium will connect all major wings of the building and all three classroom levels.

Science Wing

Science labs will be consolidated near the front of the school and highlighted to serve as a shining example of the new school.

Performing Arts

A brand new, state-of-the-art music & theater facility will serve the school and local community.

Community Resources

A child care center, public health clinic, and community food pantry will continue to serve the community.

Athletics Facilities

An entirely new gym building will include a 1,700-seat main gym, auxiliary gym, weight room, wrestling/dance room and anew softball field on site.

Career Technical Education CTE

Students in the newly modernized school will have access to specialty labs for digital design, engineering, robotics, digital art, biomedical, sculpture, construction, and sustainable agriculture, in addition to a brand-new maker space.

Construction Update

Construction has less than a year to go. The modernized campus has a new look and layout. The exteriors of the new gym and theater building are nearly complete. Much of the focus now is on interior work and that will continue throughout the coming months. Mechanical systems and insulation is followed by drying, painting and finishing work. In the spring and weather improves you'll see landscaping and site work ramp up. It won't be long before students will return to the most updated high school in the District.



Madison Renaming Project

Madison is one of two PPS high schools that are going through the process to change their names in response to student and community concerns about the racist beliefs and actions of the U.S. presidents they are named for. The effort was started by Madison students who wanted a school name that is more in line with the values of their community.
