

# PPS Bond funded seismic upgrade projects.

The PPS Bond program provides the district an opportunity to focus on seismic safety. Most of Portland Public Schools facilities were built before World War II, and well before seismic safety was a factor in the design and construction of buildings.

To address seismic issues and other important health and safety concerns, in 2012 PPS began a multi-year School Building Improvement Bond Program. The program's goal is to modernize and rebuild all the schools in the district over the next several decades as well as making health, safety and infrastructure upgrades to all schools in the short term.

A significant amount of bond work has gone toward seismic safety. So far PPS has been able to fully seismically upgrade:

Through the 2020 Bond PPS recently converted **Harrison Park** into a middle school. This work provided significant seismic upgrades to that building and made it much safer.

### SRGP Grants – Doing more with limited bond dollars.

A portion of the PPS seismic work is made possible thanks to funding from the State of Oregon's Seismic Rehabilitation Grant Program (SRGP), PPS has been able to leverage bond funds to secure additional funding for seismic work on ten of the schools so far. PPS regularly applies for these state SRGP funds. It is a bonus to the taxpayers as it allows us to do additional seismic upgrade work not originally funded by the bonds.
