



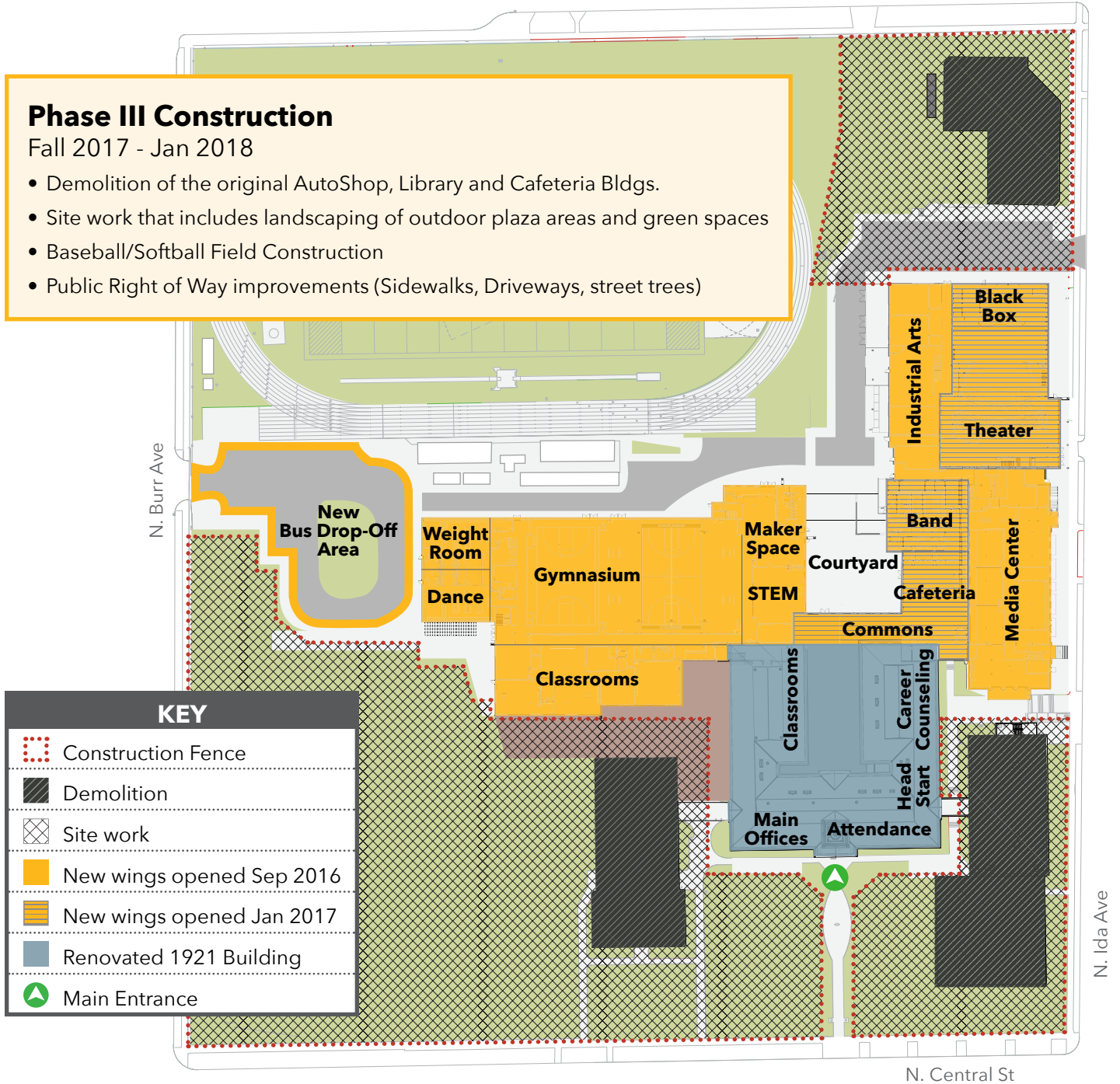

Phase III Construction

Fall 2017 - Jan 2018

- Demolition of the original AutoShop, Library and Cafeteria Bldgs.
- Site work that includes landscaping of outdoor plaza areas and green spaces
- Baseball/Softball Field Construction
- Public Right of Way improvements (Sidewalks, Driveways, street trees)



Roosevelt’s Modernization is nearly complete

At the start of the 2017 -18 school year, Roosevelt High School will be a fully functioning campus once again. The Historic 1921 building is fully modernized and ready for use. The main entrance and administration offices have returned to their former places. The expanded Commons area and Commons Courtyard are complete.

Also added are 19 additional classrooms, 3 New Science labs, several new offices, a new Head Start Day Care, a security office, and a shared-use computer lab. The beloved clock tower has been given a full makeover and will once again be a functioning timepiece.



Phase III Construction now underway

The 3rd phase of the modernization of Roosevelt, which involves site work, landscaping and the demolition of the old cafeteria, library and auto shop buildings is underway now and will continue into the fall. Completion of Phase 3 is set for January of 2018.

- Shared-Use Computer Lab

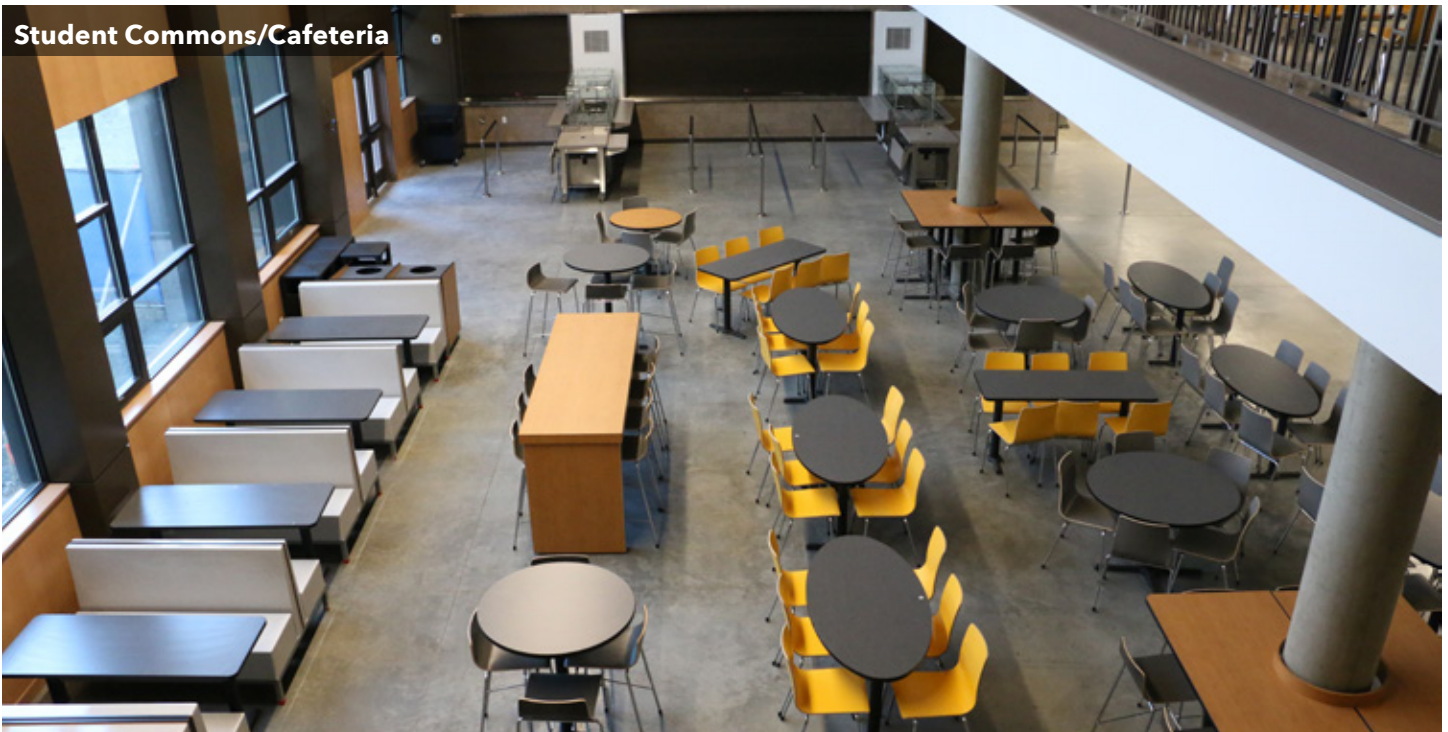

What This Means for Students & Staff

Access Points

The main door will be unlocked from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. during the school year. In addition, the gym entry doors will be unlocked from 7:45 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. After that, for security purposes, all doors outside of the main doors will open only during passing times.

The Career and Counseling Center will also enter through the main entrance and proceed to the Commons Corridor to the right.

Administration and Attendance offices will all be on the first floor of the 1921 building in suites 103 and 105. The Principal and one Vice Principal will be on the west side of main entry. Attendance and one Vice Principal will be on the east side of main entry.

The Bookkeeper is located in the Attendance office, in room 105B on the east side of the main entry.

Family and Resource Center, Room 105F will enter through the main entrance on N. Central. Spanish-speaking agents are available in this area as well as other family and community services.

Multnomah County School-Based Health Center Room 115 Please enter through the main entrance and proceed to the Career and Counseling Center corridor and then to the Health Center.

SUN and Step Up office is in room 113. Access through the main entrance and proceed to the Career and Counseling corridor.

The Roosevelt Food Pantry can be accessed through the main entrance and is located in room 091.

The Athletic Director will be in 056, across from the Main and Auxiliary Gyms. Access the entrance off of N. Burr at the bus turn around.

Security Gates will be accessed by employee card. Tickets and entry for outdoor athletic events will be available at the Burr street gate. Outdoor bathrooms and concessions are available during games. Entrance for Volleyball matches and basketball games remains at the far east end of the Gym building next to the concession area.

Accessibility

ADA accessibility is available at the Main Entrance on N. Central, the theater entrance on N. Ida Avenue, and the doors at the bus turn-around off N. Burr.

Athletics

Baseball and softball will return to Roosevelt this year. Please consult with your coach for the latest information on practice and game locations.

Classrooms

Classes are now grouped by grade level in the various wings and levels of the 1921 building. Theater, band, journalism, PE and industrial arts classes are held in their specialized classroom facilities throughout the campus. Please consult the map on page 1.

Parking

Parking inside the gates is Staff Only and can be accessed by employee card. There will be street parking only for all athletic events.

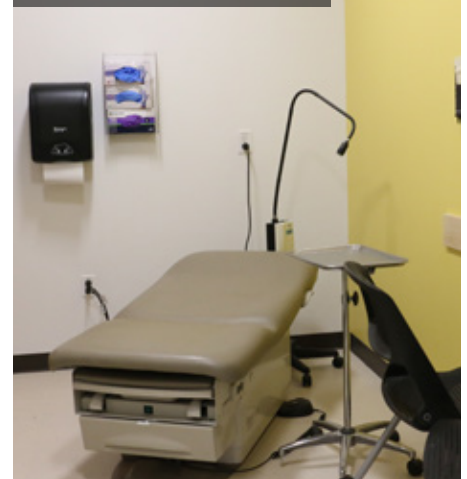
