



1:30-2:30	Content Rotations (Science, Health, and Social Studies)/ Choice Time!


Activity in Kindergarten

- **Breaks** for recess (2x per day) and snack
- **Dance & Games** twice per week
- **Arts** with specialists 2x per week
- **Yoga** and mindful breathing
- **Guided Play** times daily
