- Winners will be notified via email after the Plan - Do - Act event

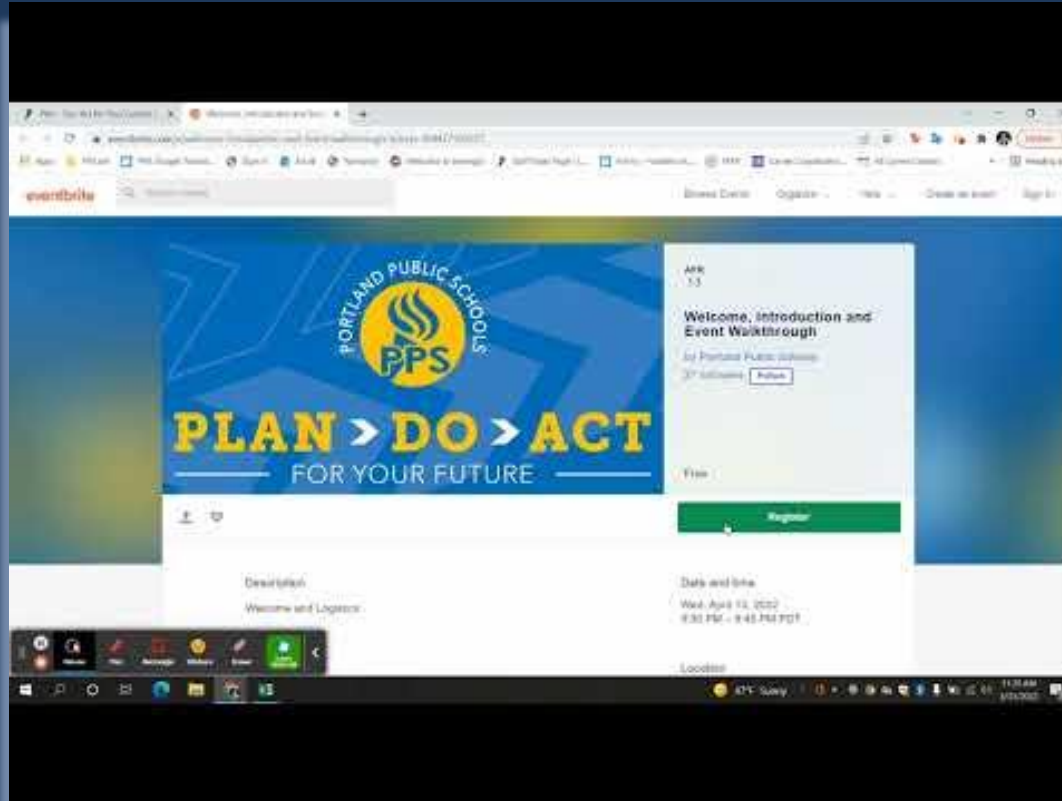
4. Get ahead in the game! Complete your PLRs required for graduation!
