WOU - Instant Wolf Preparation Guide

- 1. A <u>complete</u> Undergraduate Application for Admission: The online and PDF versions of the application are available at **wou.edu/apply**.
- Official transcripts: Please send via e-mail attachment to Lori Palmer by 5:00 p.m. No later than Wednesday October 31st. Lori's e-mail address: palmerl@wou.edu (CC me as well navareteb@wou.edu)
- 3. \$60 non-refundable admission application fee (cash or check written to "Western Oregon University"), Request for Deferral of Application Fee Form, College Board Application Fee Waiver, or NACAC Application Fee Waiver.
- 4. 3.00 minimum cumulative grade point average
- 5. **Complete 15 subject requirements with a grade of C- or better by graduation:** Four in English, three in math including Algebra II or higher, three in science, three in social science and two in the same second language.
- 6. ACT or SAT scores: Scores are optional for students who meet WOU's minimum cumulative GPA requirement of 3.00. Scores are required for students who do not meet the 3.00 GPA requirement, as well as students who are interested in designated academic scholarships, NCAA Division II athletics, or the Honors Program.
- 7. Letter of recommendation or personal statement: Students who do not meet WOU's minimum cumulative GPA requirement of 3.00 are required to provide a counselor/teacher letter of recommendation and a personal statement. A student's personal statement should address the factors that have impacted their academic performance, the steps they are taking to address academic deficiencies, and the reasons why they wish to attend WOU.

If students do not make minimum 3.0 GPA, you can also send their SAT/ACT scores personal statements and letter of recommendations to me via email.
