Construction Begins in Late Spring 2026

An All New Jefferson High School

An all-new Jefferson High School will be built at the North end of the current campus. The construction will start in the spring of 2026 and take place in phases over a four-year period with final site work to be completed in 2030. **Students and staff will remain on the campus during the 4-year construction process.**

Jefferson Plan Highlights

The new school is being designed for 1700 students and will feature modern, flexible instructional spaces to support Jeff's current and future academic, arts, and athletics programs. Design highlights include:

- New Career Technical Education [CTE] programs
- A state-of-the-art Jefferson theater
- New dance studios for the Jefferson Dancers program
- A centrally located student commons
- Dedicated spaces for local community partners and service providers.
- A new main and an auxiliary gym
- New football field, track, and grandstand
- A multi use baseball/soccer field, plus a softball field, and tennis courts
