Portland Public Schools uses ParentSquare as the primary platform for school communication. Families receive messages through email, app, voice, or text, helping everyone stay informed and involved. An account is automatically created for each parent or guardian using the contact information in our student information system. We encourage you to activate your account to download the free mobile app, set your language preferences, and choose how and when you'd like to receive messages.

ParentVUE is a secure website and mobile app which offers parents/guardians real-time access to school messages, school calendar, attendance, grades, course history, name pronunciations and much more.

# School Pay: pps.schoolpay.com

SchoolPay is an online web tool that allows families to pay for items online such as classroom and/or field trip donations, library fees and other items without having to make a special trip to the school or send cash or a check with their students. Parents and guardians are also able to use one log-in at **SchoolPay** to see all items available to them, as well as payment history for each of their students.
