

## **Supply List for Supply List for Fourth/Fifth Grade**

Please bring the items below with you during the first week of school. No need to label these items with your child's name, as we will be sharing in the classroom.

### **Community Supplies:**

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 pack container of Clorox wipes (not baby wipes)
- 2-3 or more 12-packs of Dixon Ticonderoga Pencils (we know these are a little more expensive but they are by far the highest quality. They sharpen nicely and quickly and last significantly longer than cheaper pencils.)
- 2 Medium Point Black Sharpies (4th graders bring these)
- 2 Thin Point Black Sharpies (5th graders bring these)
- 1-2 red Papermate flair pens
- 4 Glue sticks
- 2 Pkg. Post-It Notes (medium and large size, NO small size please)
- 1 Box of Band-Aids
- 1 box of Ziploc baggies QUART size (4th graders bring these)
- 1 box of Ziploc baggies SANDWICH size (5th graders bring these)
- 1 pack of wide-ruled loose leaf paper
- 2 packs of black Medium Point Flair pens
- 1 pack of thick Crayola Markers
- 1 scissors (not tiny kid sized)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's Glue
- 1 ream of copy paper (if possible)

### **Personal Supplies:**

- 3 wide ruled composition books
- 2 spiral notebooks (wide-ruled)
- 4 folders
- 1 handheld pencil sharpener
- Small pencil case that will fit inside a book box or desk (\*note: Ms. Bullard's students will be using book boxes, not the inside of desks for organizing supplies, so think small space for supplies)
- 1 Box of Colored Pencils (12-pack is fine)

Our school can always use reams of copy paper, extra Ticonderoga pencils, cardstock, watercolor pencils, and watercolor paper, etc.
