Please have your student stop by the athletic office to confirm they have completed FamilyID, AND have a valid physical on file here at Benson, or uploaded to FamilyID.

Sports Fees:

A Message from Benson's Beyond Benson Program

Attention Class of 2021 Juniors

Are you planning to go to college? Do you need help with applications and scholarships? The Beyond Benson program applications are available in the Counseling Office and during your forecasting meeting with your counselor. Applications are due February 26.

Beyond Benson matches Benson Tech juniors with a community mentor who helps students with post high school preparation. Typically, the mentors work privately with each student to provide individual assistance such as: applying for scholarships, researching colleges and completing college applications, and preparing for interviews.

If you are interested in being in the Beyond Benson program, please read the following expectations very carefully:

Qualifications: Have a 3.0 cumulative GPA and at least a C in core classes.

Meetings:

Meet with your mentor at least twice a month through the end of your senior year. Contact your mentor in advance if you have to miss a meeting. Attend small group meetings on post-high school topics. NOTE: if you have three unexcused absences, you will be dropped from the program.

Drive lessons scheduled upon registration. Parent & Student orientation on January 30th, 6pm-8pm. Class meets on Thursdays, 6pm-9pm, starting February 6th.

DMV will waive the license exam for students who complete this course. Additional auto insurance discounts may apply.

Cost is \$360, students who receive free/reduced lunch rate qualify for \$75 scholarship applied to tuition.
