Kindergarten Supply List 2018-2019

A full size backpack works best for transporting personal items and folders between home and school. Storage space is limited, so we may ask for replenishment of supplies later in the year. Occasionally, we may send a note home asking for miscellaneous materials to use when doing special units.

All items are shared so no names are needed on the supplies

12 #2 pencils **Ticonderoga sharpened** 1 box of Kleenex tissues

4 BLACK dry erase markers (Expo brand fine tip, not chisel) 1 pink eraser

1 box CRAYOLA colored pencils (12 count)
6 washable **ELMER'S** glue sticks
1 white 1 inch 3-ring binder
1 3-ring zippered pencil pouch
water bottle (please label with name)
1 **BLACK** fine point sharpie

These supplies are essential, but we don't need one per student of the following:

1 box of baby wipes
1 pack thin line classic markers (CRAYOLA 10 count)
1 pack quality watercolor paper
1 container of disinfecting wipes
1 pack thick classic markers (CRAYOLA 10 ct)
2 watercolor paint sets (CRAYOLA 8 colors)

Please send a complete change of clothes in a labeled plastic bag in your child's backpack the first week of school – it will be stored in their locker in case of emergencies. Students are encouraged, but not required, to keep an extra pair of shoes in the locker for PE days, muddy accidents and yellow puddles.

GYM SHOES

In order to protect children's safety while in Physical Education class and on the playground, we ask that students wear appropriate shoes. The shoes need to be closed toed, rubber soled and close with shoelaces or Velcro. No boots, flip-flops or sandals please. Shorts are encouraged under dresses. Teachers will let you know in the fall which days your child has PE so that you can remind your child to wear appropriate shoes on those days.

SCHOOL LUNCH PRICES

Llewellyn students may purchase breakfast at **7:40 am** each morning. Breakfast cost is **\$1.50** for students, or **free** for students who qualify for free/reduced lunches. Lunch cost is **\$2.90** or free/reduced and milk is **.50** cents. Federal lunch applications are available online at www.pps.k12.or.us/departments/nutrition/index.htm or may be picked up at the school office. A new application must be completed every year.

Money can be put in the student's account and each day a meal is purchased, the student scans their card and the price is deducted from their account.
