

Individual grade level teachers may have additional requests in the fall.

Llewellyn students may purchase breakfast at **7:40 am** each morning. Breakfast cost is **\$1.50** for students, or **free** for students who qualify for free/reduced lunches. Lunch cost is **\$2.90** or **free** and milk is **.50** cents. Money can be put in the student's account and each day a meal is purchased, the student scans their card and the price is deducted from their account.
