## Notes:

In the first table, the "\% Agree" columns combine "Strongly Agree" and "Agree" responses. In the second table, the "\% Less Problem" columns combine "Not a Problem" and "Small Problem" responses.

Percentages are found by dividing the number of respondents who answered a particular way by the total number of respondents. Total number of respondents can be found within parentheses.

Grade span percentages reflect respondents who stated that they had at least one child in that range. There is a chance that some respondents are double counted if they indicated multiple children in different grade ranges (379 respondents indicated children in multiple ranges ~ approximately $6 \%$ of sample).

In the last Demographics tables, a respondent may have marked more than one response per question. Therefore, "Total" is the total reponses of the question, which may not be the same as the total number of individuals taking the survey.
