In the third table, the "\% Mild to Insignificant" column combines "Mild Problem" and "Insignificant Problem" responses. In the fourth table, the "\% Most to Nearly All" column combines "Most Adults" and "Nearly All Adults". In the fifth table, the "\% Yes" column shows the percentage of respondents that responded "Yes". And, in the sixth table, the "\% Some to a Lot" column combines "A Lot" and "Some".

Percentages are found by dividing the number of respondents who answered a particular way by the total number of respondents. Total number of respondents can be found within parentheses.
