In the third table, the "% Mild to Insignificant" column combines "Mild Problem" and "Insignificant Problem" responses. In the fourth table, the "% Most to Nearly All" column combines "Most Adults" and "Nearly All Adults". In the fifth table, the "% Yes" column shows the percentage of respondents that responded "Yes". And, in the sixth table, the "% Some to a Lot" column combines "A Lot" and "Some".

Percentages are found by dividing the number of respondents who answered a particular way by the total number of respondents. Total number of respondents can be found within parentheses.

In the last Demographics tables, a respondent may have marked more than one response per question. Therefore, "Total" is the total reponses of the question, which may not be the same as the total number of individuals taking the survey.
