JOG-A-THON

Our recent Jog-a-Thon was a fantastic event, bringing together students from all grades to support critical staffing needs at Glencoe Elementary. The event raised an impressive \$35,097 with the participation of 367 students. Collectively, the students completed 3,365 laps around our .21-mile track, averaging 10 laps per student. The average funds raised per student amounted to \$93.

We had some standout performances in both laps completed and funds raised. The most laps completed by an individual was an impressive 18 laps, which is equivalent to 3.78 miles. The highest amount of funds raised by an individual was \$726.

At the grade level, First Grade led the way in total laps completed with 667 laps, while Second Grade topped the charts in total funds raised, bringing in \$7,774.

A big thank you goes out to all the students, parents, and supporters who made this event a resounding success. Your contributions directly support the staffing and enrichment programs that make Glencoe Elementary a wonderful place to learn and grow!
