#### **Fall Assessment Windows**

All students will take their annual fall MAP assessments throughout the month of September. These benchmark assessments are administered to measure student reading and math achievement, and provide us with useful data to help monitor their academic growth. Kindergarten - 2nd graders will take the MAP Fluency assessment, and 3rd - 5th graders will take the MAP Growth in both reading and math. These assessments will be administered again in the winter and fall to track students' progress in both areas.

#### **Student Absences and Work Policy**

If your family elects to go on vacation during the school year, **teachers will not be required to provide school work/homework before or during the vacation**. #### **TAG**




