Markham Elementary PTA PTA Meeting Minutes Portland, OR June 6, 2018

The membership meeting of Markham Elementary School was called to order in the Library of our school at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 6, 2018, by Kelly Skelton, President. Proper notice was given to all members through the district calendar, school newsletter and reminder emails and posts. A quorum of members as stated in the Standing Rules was present. A sign-in sheet is attached to these minutes (Attachment A).

Introductions:

Kelly Skelton asked everyone to introduce themselves.

Guest Speaker:

Lauren from Green School House -

Green School House helps teachers take their curriculum and translate it into the garden and outdoor spaces. Our current Green School House Educator, Brooke, was brought in to Markham because we requested more produce for the cafeteria and Brooke has knowledge on production farming and works with Candy Lane Farms. Lauren is requesting \$10,000 to fund their program for 2018-2019 school year. \$10,000 would allow an educator, such as Brooke, to come in once a week for 30-60 minutes per class for fall, winter and spring. \$5,000 would only fund this program during fall and spring. Green School House partnered with Dig In and was funded by nonprofits for this current year, 2017-2018. They need a commitment within the next month for a fall 2018 commitment.

Preliminary Business:

Minutes from the last PTA meeting (on May 2, 2018) were presented by Kelly Skelton. Joelle Alexander motioned to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Heather Rawlins and the minutes were approved.

The agenda for this meeting was presented by Kelly Skelton (Attachment B).

Principal's Report – Shawn Garnett, Principal:

• Met with Tracy, from the school district, and Al Carlson, Custodian, about our bubblers/water fountains. Markham is set to get phase one of the drinking fountains in the hallways replaced this summer. There is no date scheduled for phase two, which includes the bubblers in the classrooms. The sinks in the cafeteria have already been approved and recommissioned. The other sinks are not approved right now. Shawn will request water bottle filling stations in addition to the water fountains. Alissa Maxwell motioned the PTA to fund up to \$3,000 out of the \$10,000 capital improvement funds to go towards funding the water bottle filling stations should the district not cover the cost. Joelle Alexander seconded, and the motion was approved.

Treasurer's Report – Tom Simpson, Treasurer:

Tom provided an Income and Expenses Report as of June 6th, 2018 (**Attachment C**). Two PTA members reviewed and approved current bank reconciliations.

Several checks were written for all the teacher requests that were approved last PTA meeting.

We brought in several Fun Run deposits equaling \$10,720, plus \$1,400 which hasn't been deposited.

We received \$708 from corporate matches, including Kroger/Fred Meyer.

Still waiting on Pot Belly check for the fundraiser night.

An additional \$680 came in from the auction.

Total income for the year increased by \$15,470.

Unfinished Business:

Ms. Weidner decided not to put film on her classroom window because she learned the natural sunlight wouldn't come through. Therefore, we do not need to provide \$1,000 for window film.

New Business:

Fun Run T-Shirts - Alissa Maxwell

T-Shirts are available, and help is needed to fold and organize them tonight.

Calendar - Alissa Maxwell

Alissa handed out the proposed the PTA calendar for 2018-2019 (**Attachment D**). The only major change is switching dates for Literacy Night and Global Village. This will help with getting more families to participate in the Global Village. Valentine's Day needs to be added to February and the Valentine's Day in March needs to be renamed to PI Day. At the September 5th PTA meeting the calendar will be finalized and voted on.

PBOT Capitol Highway Project - Charles Radosta

Capitol Highway will be redone for sidewalks and bike lanes. PBOT will reach out to Shawn Garnett to schedule an informational Open House at Markham in the fall.

Sensory Closet/Storage - Alissa Maxwell for Becky Stephens

Becky Stephens is proposing to create a Sensory Closet to assist student learning. The closet would have wiggle chairs, weighted blankets, and other tools. She is asking for \$1,000 to start ordering and purchasing sensory items. Alissa will request a presentation on what items she will purchase with the \$1,000 and will propose the \$1,000 budget at the PTA Board meeting.

Chess for Success – Alissa Maxwell

Chess for Success reached out to Markham about adding their program. Sun School may provide it and may ask PTA for the funds to run it.

Auction Planning for 2018-2019 - Ally Keo

Committee is meeting at 7:00pm on June 12th at McMenamins, Hillsdale to discuss venue and other preliminary information.

Committee Reports:

Hospitality - Joelle Alexander

Fifth grade promotion will be Friday. The Fifth-grade promotion and Fifth-grade BBQ should have separate committees as there is a lot of work for each event.

Fun Run

We made \$12,000. Ms. Franklin's class won most laps, and Ms. Savage's class won most dollars donated.

Global Village - Heather Rawlins

There was a smaller number of attendees compared to past years, but it was still a great turnout.

<u>Used Book Sale – Cari Carr</u>

The sale went really well. In addition, they got rid of about 3,200 books that weren't purchased or relevant for future sales.

Connect to Kindergarten – Kelly Skelton for Sarah Black

Connect to Kindergarten went well. There were about 20 attendees.

5th Grade BBQ – Joelle Alexander

We got a second BBQ so all we need next year is two propane tanks.

Bike and Roll to School - Charles Radosta

Everything went well. Switching to Fridays rather than Wednesdays seemed to work out.

Field Day - Sarah Simons

Mr. Johnson asked for some new items for Field Day. Sarah had a great turnout of volunteers. Popsicles were more expensive than we budgeted because we have more

students enrolled than previous years. The budget should be increased. Popsicles should not all be dairy based.

Yearbooks - Ally Keo

Yearbooks have been delivered and there are a few in the front office for sale (\$17).

Restaurant Fundraiser – Ally Keo

Membership agreed to have restaurant fundraisers for next year, but not over the summer.

Garden - Misty Plock

Ms. Garnett is going to ask Lauren from Green School House whether or not their program will include repairing and maintaining the garden boxes. We need more information about their program before we can make a decision to provide funding.

Scrip – Christine Stonecliffe

Profit for the school year was \$2,215. The scrip dates over the summer are Tuesday, July 9th and Monday, August 6th.

We are still looking for a new Scrip coordinator.

Volunteer Request for 2018-2019 – Alissa Maxwell

We have a new volunteer coordinator, Jamila Wahab. We also have a lot of parents stepping up and filling in volunteer positions.
