School Fundraising Information

With the District's proposed changes to the Local School Foundation model, I wanted to clarify the roles of each of Glencoe's fundraising bodies - the Foundation and the PTA. This [flier](#) gives details on the who, what, and how of each entity, and clarifies the differences.

Foundation Information From the District

As we think about cuts to educational funding, and how Glencoe's Local School Foundation aims to help mitigate them, I wanted to share some information from PPS.

For context, this year, our LSF provided an additional .75 FTE toward staffing at Glencoe. This includes roles in our front office, providing an additional PE teacher, and rounding out FTE for our Educational Assistant. We are hoping to raise enough funds this spring to be able to retain at least the .25 FTE for front office staff. If there is additional funding available, the priority would be to use that toward student-facing support.

*Background: The **Portland Teachers Levy** currently funds over 655 teaching positions a year, or about **20% of all teaching positions in PPS**. Measure 26-246 would preserve these positions for another 5 years at the same tax rate.*
