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Dear Students & Parents of Faubion:

Spring is here and Faubion SUN CS is excited to bring you some great classes this term! Attached is a comprehensive list of activities you have to choose from, along with a registration & a release of information form. **The enclosed forms are necessary for you to complete in order to grant your child permission to participate in our after school programs. REMEMBER SUN classes fill up quickly, so forms not completely filled out may result in not getting into desired class.**

Registration: Forms are due Wednesday, April 5th

Return completed forms to the main office. Parents will receive a confirmation call with your child's schedule by April 10th. Electronic copies will be sent to those who provide an e-mail address. **Remember, registration form must be completely filled out!** Filling out the SUN form does not guarantee enrollment.

Daily Schedule: Monday - Thursday, no classes on Friday

3:15pm-3:45pm	Supper/Recess	Meets with staff in designated area, Per COVID guidelines students are expected to stay and eat with their cohorts.
3:45pm-5:15pm	Enrichment Classes	Students will be escorted to their class with instructor.
5:15pm-5:30pm	Pick Up	For pick-up, check in at the SUN entrance by playground . The front doors of the school will be locked during SUN.

Enrollment Eligibility:

SUN programming is available for elementary and middle age students in the Faubion community. Enrollment in extended day programs is prioritized for students who are referred by Faubion teachers or are identified as needing acceleration to meet benchmark as part of SUN's goal to help close achievement gaps. **Depending on the volume of forms received, families can expect their students to participate in up to 3 days per week with the potential for students to be waitlisted. We will make our best effort to accommodate your class selections; however, we cannot guarantee that every class you choose will be available.** Your flexibility helps with this challenging registration process.

SUN After School Course Descriptions

K Club (Kindergarten, Monday -Thursday) Help prepare for the 1st grade. We can develop basic skills and social behavior by handicrafts, books, games, exercise, ect.

Faubion SUN Sports (Grades 1-8, Monday / Wednesday) Develop skills in athletics, making plays, and being part of a team. When weather is rainy, head to the gym for drills and other fun games!

LEGO Robotics (Grades 5-8, Monday / Wednesday) Provide STEM programing in the form of Lego Robotics activities and group prjects. Help improve with teamwork and self-confidence by presentations and public speaking.

Bulldog Basketball (Grades 2-8, Tuesday &Thursday) Improve basic basketball fundamentals and conditioning. Help strengthen shooting, dribbling, passing, and teamwork. Group drills and team practicingGet a team for the day and use your skills and practice training to use in competitive team basketball competition.

Chess for Success! (Grades 2-8, Wednesday/ Thursday) This class will help those with little or no previous experience understand the game of chess. Learn how pieces move, basic tactics, and how to checkmate. Play friendly games of chess with your peers in a low-stress environment. Help improve problem-solving skills and social skills.

Growing Gardens (Grades 1-3, Monday) Discover new plants and creations with the SpringGarden Club! Join us for nature-based arts and crafts while our garden overwinters.

Oregon Ballet Theatre (Grades Kindergarten-2, Wednesday) Take the first steps to become a trained dancer through contemporary ballet. Come join the performances.

Hip- Hop Dance (Grades 2-5, Monday) Dancers will stretch, learn how to wok as a team, and create dance routines with a special performance at then end of the term. Come and join us on the dance floor! Instr: Kelsi

Tutoring (Grades 1-8, Monday-Thursday) Tutoring help and encouraging students to do their best work with their homework in a positive learning environment. Parents and Teachers can connect with SUN Tutors with certain needs for students to polish up in certain areas. Please mark in notes!

Arts & Crafts (Grades 1-5, Wednesday) Tap in to your creative side with a wide variety of art activities where you get to create crafts and take home to share.

Reading Rainbow (Grades 1st - 5th, Tuesday & Thursday) Are you ready to be creative? Take a seat and see what a great combination of story telling and creative art can do. Students gets to take home their creative inventions.

Faubion SUN Community School is a collaboration of Portland Public Schools, Multnomah County, the City of Portland and many community partners and agencies who come together to support children's success in school and life. We do this by working together to meet the specific needs of our students and their families.

In order to provide your child with the best services and support possible, the SUN Community School Site Manager needs your permission to be able to share information with the people who are teaching and serving your child specifically. This information may include student name, student ID#, grade level, achievement test scores, course grades and grade point averages, attendance, Individual Education Plan, demographic, and behavior/discipline information. The SUN Community School Site Manager will only share this information when it is required by a partner organization or supports your student's success. This information may also be shared with the City/County SUN Initiative and their evaluation contractors for program evaluation.

Organizations receiving information about your student are informed of state and federal confidentiality provisions. This includes employees and volunteers managed by the Faubion SUN Community School site manager and staff of other partner agencies providing the activities in which your child participates. They are not authorized to release information to any agency or person not listed in this release without specific written consent of the parent/legal guardian.

Children may participate in SUN activities whether or not their Parent/Guardian agrees to the release or exchange of educational information to other staff or agencies.
